Victor Harbor Coastcare - Treasurer's Report April 2023

The past year has been extraordinary because of receiving unusually large incoming funds that have provided us with an unaccustomed peace-of-mind buffer. \$7,000 was donated to Victor Harbor Coastcare by South Coast Environment Centre when they closed, \$1,000 was received from Landcare Australia for winning the South Australian Coastcare award, and \$614 was received from other donors.

Notable expenses were \$990 for a bushcare contractor to do follow-up work on casuarina glauca on the Bluff and \$600 for four Coastcare members to attend the Australian Coastal Forum at Marion Bay.

I will be proposing that subscriptions remain at \$10 per member, with the intention that 'normal' expenses will continue to be almost covered by 'normal' income. It was agreed at the February meeting that new members won't pay anything until the start of the following subscription year.

Most of the exceptional funds are being held in term deposits until spending on future projects has been decided.
